Ocean Week Canada: Celebrating Our Connection to the Ocean

Across geographies and generations, Ocean Week Canada 2024 saw 393 events take place in all provinces and territories. Throughout these events, culture, language, knowledge systems, and history were celebrated in unique ways.

The Canadian Ocean Literacy Coalition (COLC) has the honour of serving as the national lead for Ocean Week Canada. Now in its third year, the festival reached hundreds of communities in Canada and more than 6,000,000 people.

More partners than ever before (411) came together to bring Ocean Week Canada to life this year. That's a 75% increase over 2023, and a testament to the growing interest. We are inspired to see the ways regional hubs are expanding. There were 10 hubs in 2024, up from 6 in 2023, and each engaging communities in grassroots efforts to strengthen societal-ocean connections.

The Community Grants program also expanded this year. COLC distributed 49 grants totalling \$111,891 to support community events, artists and creators, and the Ocean Week Canada movement. Each one of those grantees created an experience that helps to build public knowledge of the ocean, strengthen ocean values, and inspire action to protect it.

Ocean Week Canada is an essential part of collaborative efforts to restore a healthy relationship between people and the ocean. Our own health and community well-being, regardless of where we each call home, are dependent on this relationship.












Ocean Week Canada is nationally coordinated by the <u>Canadian Ocean Literacy</u> <u>Coalition</u> (COLC) project office. COLC works with hundreds of partners and event hosts each year to coordinate a national program of events.
